

Re-silicone Profile 2010

Re-silicone centre's round the design and production of bespoke eco-conscious products and large-scale installations made from re-used rubber silicone.

Re-silicone was founded in 2007 by Lucy Fergus, a graduate of MA Design for Textile Futures at Central Saint Martins College of Art and Design. Following the success of Re-silicone lights, the continuous supply of rubber silicone inspired a diverse range of new products from floor coverings to jewellery.

As the supply of silicone is dependent on customer demand and specification, the element of unpredictability is a key feature of the Re-silicone brand, celebrating the concept of waste and re-use to inform the design process.

Re-silicone is also supported by the iconic and quintessentially British east London hairbrush manufacturer, Mason Pearson using their natural rubber off-cuts for large-scale installation pieces. Recent projects include Elephant Parade London 2010 and the COLLECT Trail at Duke of York square for the Crafts Council.

Dedicated to raising awareness for industrial waste, Lucy has also coordinated and run Re-silicone creative materials workshops with Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital, the City of London Festival, the Science Museum and Surrey Council.
